## PRAYERS FOR PATIENTS AT THE END OF LIFE

During this pandemic, chaplains will not always be able to attend the wards. As a Christian nurse, you may be invited by your matron or ward manager to offer religious support to a dying patient.

People who are dying may often seem to be unconscious or semi responsive. We know that often enough there is good awareness, and that, even though there may be no response, they will participate in prayers and listen.

Therefore, the prayers below may be said because they are effective in helping the dying on their journey to meet our Lord, and because, if said aloud in the presence of the person dying, that person will know that those who care and love them are near.

The following short texts may be said with the dying person. They may be softly repeated two or three times.

Who will separate us from the love of Christ? ... For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:35 and 38

I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong and he shall comfort your heart; wait patiently for the Lord.

Psalm 27:13,14

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
